


KEY DESTINATIONS IN VIETNAM



HALONG BAY

A breathtaking seascape where over 3000 limestone pinnacles rise from the emerald sea.



HUE

Once the imperial capital of Vietnam during the Nguyen dynasty, the town is scattered with ancient temples, imperial buildings, vast tombs and French-style edifices.



HO CHI MINH CITY

Aged traditions meet modern living where ornate pagodas, bustling markets, and ramshackle wooden shops jostle for space with chic restaurants and luxury hotels.



SAPA

This northern gateway opens another world of mysterious minority cultures and luscious landscapes of terraced rice paddies, deep valleys, high mountains and waterfalls.



HANOI

The tangled maze of the Old Quarter will transport you back to the days of 'Old Asia' while gracious mansions, tree-lined parks and lakes evoke French colonial memories.



HOI AN

This UNESCO World Heritage Site boasts colorful shop houses, pagodas, communal houses and family chapels that line the narrow streets dating back to the 16th and 17th centuries.



NHA TRANG

A seaside town bordered by mountains and famous for its beautiful bay, pristine beaches and islands.



DANANG

The stretch of golden sands between Danang is a gleaming invitation to relax for a few days, while the confident nightlife is among the most sophisticated in Vietnam.

CAMBODIA



ABOUT CAMBODIA

Once home to the powerful Khmer Kingdom, Cambodia was off limits to the tourist trail for many years and its secrets lay undiscovered for centuries. Dating back to the 12th and 13th centuries the awe-inspiring Angkor temples were abandoned and eventually became hidden by thick forests - until they were rediscovered in 1860.



KEY DESTINATIONS IN CAMBODIA



BANLUNG

Banlung is the capital of Ratanakiri province, an undiscovered region home to many minorities who have their own customs and traditions.



BATTAMBANG

A quiet laidback city, Battambang was founded in the 11th century by the Khmer Empire and is home to the bamboo train, a unique form of ad-hoc local transportation.



KEP

Kep's luxurious seaside villas and mansions were abandoned and left to ruin when the Khmer Rouge took over the country in the seventies.



KOH RONG

Dense jungle and coconut trees merge with sandy coves and coral reefs on this pristine island.



SIEM REAP

This is the gateway to the stunning Angkor Wat temple complex that contains the magnificent remains of the Khmer Empire dating from the 9th to the 15th century. A river runs through the centre of the town and the area around the Old Market is burgeoning with shops, galleries, restaurants and bars.



PHNOM PENH

Cambodia's capital is a chaotic and hectic city where open air cafes line the riverside road and French colonial houses sit behind high walls on tree-lined boulevards.



KAMPOT

Set on the Kampot River, Kampot is best known for its classic colonial architecture, and laidback riverside scene.



SIHANOUKVILLE

Located on the Gulf of Thailand, Sihanoukville is Cambodia's most popular seaside resort and a major coastal port.


MYANMAR



ABOUT MYANMAR

Shrouded in mystery, Myanmar - formerly known as Burma - is often referred to as the Golden Land. Due to being cut off from the rest of the world for many years, Myanmar has retained all of its culture, spirituality and old world charm.

KEY DESTINATIONS IN MYANMAR



KYAIKHTO

Kyaikhto is a town in the Mon State of south-east Myanmar and is the nearest town to Kyaiktiyo Pagoda (or the Golden Rock), a famous landmark and one of the most ancient and celebrated of all pagodas in Myanmar.



YANGON

Yangon retains much of the charm of its colonial heritage with gracious architecture, tranquil lakes, shady parks and tree-lined avenues. The gleaming golden stupa of the Shwedagon Pagoda is the centrepiece of the city.



INLE LAKE

Nestled among the Shan Mountains are the glassy blue waters of Inle Lake. Rimmed by high hills, the lake is dotted with idyllic patches of floating vegetation, fishing canoes, floating markets and fish farms.



PYIN OO LWIN

A lovely former British hill station, with a pleasantly cool climate. Its colonial heritage is evident in the colorful horse-drawn carriages, and colonial mansions



BAGAN

Bagan is a vast, empty plain, dotted with thousands of stupas and temple ruins as far as the eye can see. It is estimated that as many as 13,000 temples once stood on this 42 square kilometre plain.



NGAPALI

Named by homesick Italian sailors after their beloved Naples, Ngapali is a scenic and peaceful retreat. Miles of unspoiled sandy beach, brilliant turquoise seas and towering coconut trees make Ngapali a perfect place to unwind.



MERGUI

Consisting of more than 800 islands this is one of the few island regions in Asia to remain virtually untouched.



MANDALAY

Mandalay is considered the cultural and religious capital of Myanmar. The greater Mandalay area is actually composed of five different towns: Mandalay, Amarapura, Sagaing, Mingun and Inwa, each of which has its own special atmosphere and highlights.

ABOUT LAOS



KEY DESTINATIONS IN LAOS



SAVANNAKHET

This riverside town has an atmosphere of faded French colonial grandeur with tall trees shading crumbling French-era buildings and narrow streets lined with shop houses of ochre-coloured stucco.



VIENTIANE

The capital of Laos since 1563, Vientiane is located on a curve of the Mekong River, bordering Thailand. This tranquil city is scattered with crumbling French mansions and steaming noodle stalls.



PAKSE

Pakse sits at the confluence of the Mekong River and the Don River, and is the capital of Champasak Province. Nearby are the ruins of Vat Phou.



OUDOMXAY

Laos' northern-most area boasts a rugged mountainous landscape, untouched nature and a diverse culture of hill tribes.



LUANG PRABANG

Luang Prabang has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is situated on the Mekong River in a stunning river valley surrounded by dramatic mountains.




PHONSAVAN

LUANG NAM THA

This lush forested and mountainous province in the north west of Laos is surrounded by a patchwork of rich rice paddies and ethnically diverse villages.

The small town of Vang Vieng is nestled in a scenic bend in the Nam Song River surrounded by breathtaking limestone karsts honeycombed with an extensive network of tunnels and caves.

KEY DESTINATIONS IN THAILAND



KRABI

The coastline of Krabi is dotted with limestone cliffs and pinnacles that rise out of the turquoise sea.



BANGKOK

The capital city is a mix of modern and traditional. Sky-high office blocks, international shopping centres and elegant restaurants compete for space with Buddhist temples, rickety wooden houses and steamy food stalls.



AYUTTHAYA

One of the ancient capitals of the Kingdom of Siam is now an important archeological site containing palaces and photo-worthy Buddhist temples. The location 80km north of Bangkok makes a perfect excursion.



KOH SAMUI/PHI PHI

Island life here offers palm tree-fringed beaches, a mountainous interior and a turquoise sea perfect for snorkelling.



CHIANG MAI

The Rose of the North contains over 300 ancient chedis and temples. The original city layout still exists as a neat square surrounded by a moat with a fortified wall and four main gates.




CHIANG RAI




KEY DESTINATIONS IN INDONESIA


KALIMANTAN

Undiscovered and exotic: this region of Borneo conjures visions of mythical people, ancient forests and mighty rivers.




SUMATRA


BANGALORE

A tropical landscape of palm tree-lined beaches, lush steamy jungles, aromatic hills and countless winding rivers.




GOA
